#### Paper, Trees and Me

Program Description: Trees are our best friends as we explore the paper making process from start to finish. This program includes creative dramatics, a story, and handson fun as we explore trees, paper, and the role of recycling. Students will create their own environmentally-friendly piece of paper!



## <u>Math</u>

In Math, students will be representing and describing a number in two parts up to 10, using a variety of materials. Students will also explore numbers 11 to 15 in French.

#### Science

In Science this month our theme is paper. We will learn French vocabulary related to paper, identify paper that can be found in our classroom, and recognize that paper is most often made from trees. We will also compare characteristics of different kinds of paper.

#### Social Studies

This month's focus in Social Studies is on Indigenous teachings.

On Thursdays starting on March 7 Mme Bergunder, our divisional Indigenous Student Support Teacher, will spend the first part of the morning with us. Kindergarten students will learn about the 7 Teachings and the animals associated with each one. We will explore the concepts of love, humility, courage, respect, honesty, wisdom and truth for 8 consecutive Thursdays. Our program will wrap up on Thursday, May 2. What a wonderful opportunity to learn about the world through Indigenous perspectives!
